TOILETS

Due to current BO Covid requirements, a clear queuing system will need to be marked around the toilet area to maintain social distancing and to encourage a one-way system. Hand sanitiser MUST be used by all competitors prior to using any toilet facilities. In addition, when standard toilets are being used inside a building, there will need to be a restriction on the number of people queuing inside the building and a clear system inside and outside to manage this.

PORTALOOS

These will need to be hired for events where there is no access to standard toilets.

- Organiser to book toilets and plan where they are to be sited.
- Order one Portaloo per 100 competitors (minimum of 2 toilets per event) and include 1
 urinal if possible. This will be more important at large National and Major events with more
 competitors. Toilets are unisex.
- Toilets to be delivered the day before the event if possible (check insurance) but must be on site by 8.30am to allow for helpers and early competitors.
- Allocate someone to keep an eye on the toilets, or to be readily available if there are reports
 of issues, to ensure toilet paper does not run out and there is always sufficient hand
 sanitiser. Hand sanitiser is vital to comply with BO Covid requirements.
- Hand sanitiser to be available outside the toilets and inside each individual toilet throughout the event.
- Ensure plenty of toilet paper is available.

STANDARD TOILETS:

Where standard toilets are available the Organiser needs to ensure the following:-

- Toilets are in good working order and with a good flush to cope with the number of people using them.
- Hand sanitiser is available before the toilets to comply with BO Covid requirements so competitors do not touch anything with un-sanitised hands.
- There is sufficient toilet paper at all times.
- There are good hand washing facilities including soap and paper towels to dry hands.
- There is hand sanitiser available in the hand washing area.
- Someone is allocated to keep an eye on the toilets, or be readily available, to deal with any issues that arise to minimise numerous competitors handling things.
