Accessible by wheelchair.

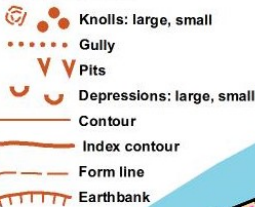
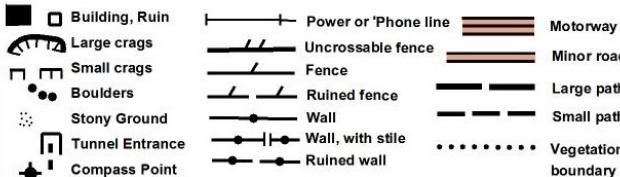
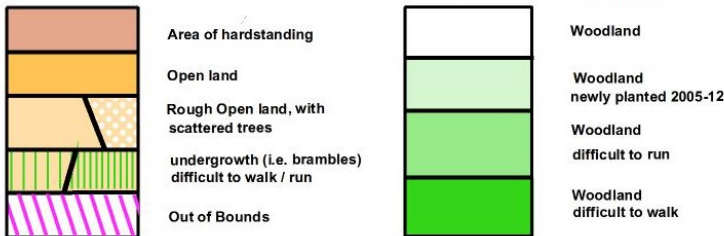
